**There is no need to thank me for this valuable information, I am doing it as a public service.**

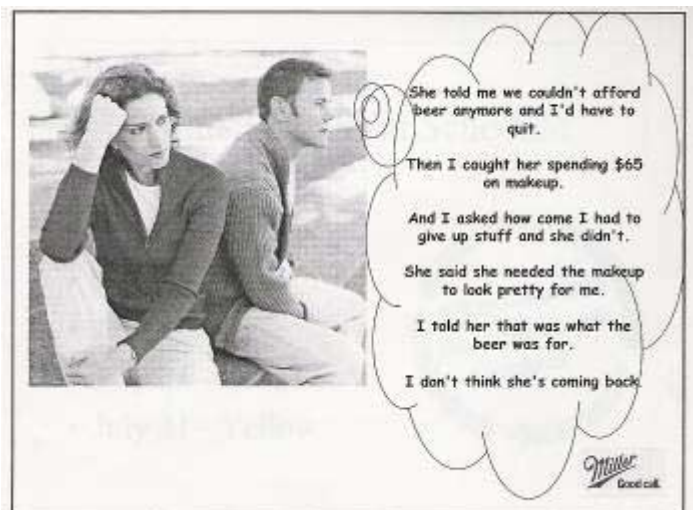

**Kennington - 18<sup>th</sup> September 2006**  
**The Prince of Wales**  
**Hares - Half Cock & Daffydildo**

"I forgot to nominate someone to do the write-up at the start" says Ryde, sneaking up on me as I am tucking into my fifth pint of Whitstable Bay Organic Ale in the pub after the run. "I know you were one of the hares, but could you do it? You only have to do two sentences, and if you like you can say it was the best trail ever."

I must admit I had been somewhat puzzled when my chief hare phoned me whilst out reccie-ing the trail the week before, saying that she was in St James's Park, but as a humble co-hare I simply assumed that I had misheard and that she really meant Kennington Park. After all, what is the point of setting a trail from Kennington if not to run round all those lovely council estates? But how wrong I was.



The aforementioned Half Cock and I bravely decided to set the trail on the Sunday night before the run and then pray for no rain, and come Monday evening we were relieved to find the markings still intact.

Being situated in a quiet residential square, the landlord of the Prince of Wales had requested that we not make a noise, so as to avoid the neighbours complaining and jeopardising his licence. And so it was that Peacemaker set us off with a hushed opening circle, and we jogged out of the corner of the square to the sound of whispered "on-on"s.
